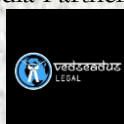

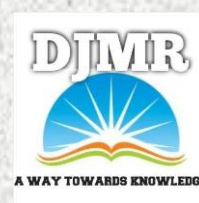

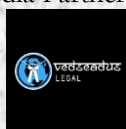
### ***About Doon Journal of Multidisciplinary Research (DJMR) Doon Journal of***

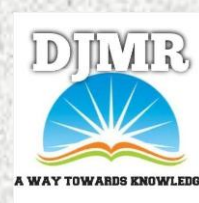
### ***About Knowledge Steez EduHub***

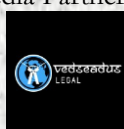
### ***About the Conference***

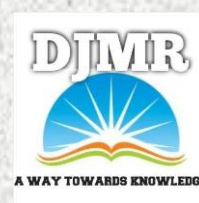

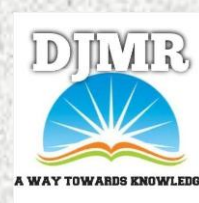
### **NO REGISTRATION FEES FOR PAPER PRESENTATION**
